Gathering Song:

*The Call to Worship

Liturgist: The glory of God shines like a consuming fire.
People: We have seen the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
Liturgist: The voice of God thunders like a mighty storm.
People: Out of the clouds, God speaks: This is my beloved Son; listen to him!
Liturgist: Embraced in the power and presence of the Lord, let us worship God!

*Opening Hymn: Immortal, Invisible, God Only Wise

*A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

God alone is righteous. God alone is wholly other. God alone is judge. Yet, this holy, righteous God comes to us in love, to save us. Rejoicing in God's grace, let us confess our sin.

*Unison Prayer of Confession (prayed aloud by all)

Holy God, we confess that we do not trust you fully. We put our hope in worldly gain and in human promises, and find ourselves defeated and lost when things fall apart. You have given us a love more fully than anything we could experience in this world but we do not seek it, we do not hold on to it, and we look to our own means of assurance and security. Forgive us. Call us back to You that we may put our trust in You and not be afraid. May we hear the words so clearly as the disciples did on the day of the Transfiguration; may we rise up, and not be afraid. In the name of Jesus, who loves us and offers us forgiveness, we pray. Amen.

The Silent Confession (please be seated)

The Sung Response to Confession: Open Our Eyes, Lord Open our eyes, Lord, we want to see Jesus. To reach out and touch Him and say that we love Him. Open our ears, Lord, and help us to listen. Open our eyes, Lord, we want to see Jesus.

The Declaration and Assurance of Forgiveness

Liturgist: Our God comes and does not keep silent. God speaks with promise making truth that we are God's beloved.

People: This is the good news of the gospel. In Jesus, we are forgiven. Thanks be to God!

*Passing the Peace of Christ, Sharing in Christ's Welcome

Liturgist: Peace be with you.

People: And, also with you.

(Congregation shares peace with one another in the pew, over the phone, across the screen.)
