*A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

*Unison Prayer of Confession (prayed aloud by all)

Lord God, in the light of your glory, we see the evil we have done, the suffering we have caused, the good we have refused and the truth we have denied. Heal us of our sin. Redeem us from our wrongdoing. Wash us in your mercy and feed us with the manna of your grace. Embolden us once again to walk in righteousness and truth. Empower us to tell the good news of the gospel, that though we have been lost, You keep on finding us again and again by Your love. Amen.

The Declaration and Assurance of Forgiveness

Liturgist: Rise up from the dust! Cast off your graveclothes! People: Put on the joy of the Lord because in Jesus Christ we are forgiven! Thanks be to God! Amen!

Liturgist: Peace be with you.

People: And, also with you.
