Welcome

Gathering Song:

*The Call to Worship

Liturgist: From the mustard seed a great and mighty shrub emerges. **People: Good things can come from something that seems so insignificant.** Liturgist: The spore of the yeast can leaven the whole loaf of bread. **People: We can be those people who bring hope and peace to God's world.** Liturgist: Come, let us praise the God of great and mighty wonders. **People: Let our spirits soar in gratitude for the opportunities God gives us to serve. *A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

People: And, also with you.


