*The Call to Worship

Liturgist: Alleluia! Christ is risen. People: He is risen indeed. Alleluia!

Liturgist: Praise the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

People: He has given us new life and hope. He has raised Jesus from the dead.

Liturgist: God has claimed us as his own.

People: He has brought us out of darkness. He has made us light to the world.

Liturgist: Alleluia! Christ is risen. **People: He is risen indeed. Alleluia!**

A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

Unison Prayer of Confession (prayed aloud by all)

Lord, bring new life where we are worn and tired; new love where we have turned hard-hearted; forgiveness where we feel hurt and where we have wounded, and the joy and freedom of your Holy Spirit where we are prisoners of ourselves.

Silent Confession Please take a moment for silent confession

Asking for God's Forgiveness

Liturgist: Let us now ask God's forgiveness.

People: Forgive us, God of mercy. Help us to trust your power to change our lives and make us new, that we may know the joy of life abundant given in Jesus Christ, the risen Lord. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon

Liturgist: All of us, like sheep, have gone astray, but now we have returned to the shepherd and guardian of our souls. In Jesus Christ, we are forgiven.

People: Thanks be to God. Alleluia!

Sung Response to Confession: Be Not Afraid

Be not afraid; sing out for joy! Christ is risen, alleluia! Be not afraid; sing out for joy! Christ is risen, alleluia!

People: And, also with you.


