our nation. Stir our imaginations that we may discover new pathways and raise in us the courage to be your faithful people, even in this trying time. Amen.

#### **Assurance of Pardon**

Liturgist: Jesus became as we are that we might become as he is. In Jesus Christ, God forgives us and works to make us new. Trust this good news.

People: Thanks be to God!
