## A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

We are mindful that we have fallen short in faith, hope and love. Trusting in God's goodness, we can be honest with God and with ourselves. Let us confess our sin.

### Unison Prayer of Confession (prayed aloud by all)

God, too many days we hit the ground running. We rush ourselves and are easily annoyed with red lights and slow cashiers. We think that we can live at "full tilt" and are surprised when our bodies say to us, "too much." Too often we do not observe a sabbath day, we eat on the run, and we burn too many candles.

## Asking for God's Forgiveness

Liturgist: Let us now ask God's forgiveness.

People: God, forgive us our frantic paces and our blindness to opportunities you give for restoration. Help us to honor you by honoring our bodies that you have created. Help us to explore daily rhythms that include times for rest and renewal so that we may be healthy in mind, body and spirit. Amen.

#### **Assurance of Pardon**

Liturgist: This saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. He himself bore our sins in his body on the cross, that we might be dead to sin, and alive to all that is good. I declare to you in the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven.

People: Thanks be to God!

Sung Response to Confession: Blest Be the Tie That Binds
Blest be the tie that binds our hearts in Christian love.
The fellowship of kindred minds is like to that above.

Liturgist: The peace of Christ be with you.


