A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

When we are bold and take an honest inventory of our lives, we realize that we have fallen short of God's intention for us. In humility and candor let us confess our sin to God.

Unison Prayer of Confession (prayed aloud by all)

Gracious God, our sins are too heavy to carry, too real to hide, and too deep to undo.

Silent Confession Please take a moment for silent confession

Asking for God's Forgiveness

Liturgist: Let us now ask God's forgiveness.

People: Merciful God, forgive what our lips tremble to name, what our hearts can no longer bear, and what has become for us a consuming fire of judgement. Set us free from a past that we cannot change; open to us a future in which we can be changed; and grant us grace to grow more and more in your likeness and image; through Jesus Christ, the light of the world. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon

Liturgist: God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. This is our good news: in Jesus Christ, God has forgiven us.

People: Amen! Thanks be to God!

Sung Response to Confession: Blest Be the Tie That Binds

Blest be the tie that binds our hearts in Christian love. The fellowship of kindred minds is like to that above.

*Passing the Peace of Christ, Sharing in Christ's Welcome

Liturgist: The peace of Christ be with you.

People: And, also with you.

Liturgist: Let us stand and share the peace of Christ with one another.
