A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

In a world with so much fear we dare to trust in God's goodness and love. Believing Christ's promises, let us embrace our humanity in prayer.

Unison Prayer of Confession (prayed aloud by all)

We know we have caused hurt, harmed others, and made some pretty big mistakes. But this morning, God, we ask your forgiveness for the times we believed that our sins somehow make us less worthy of your love. Forgive us for listening to the voice of fear and shame instead of your stories of Good News. Help us remember that your love has no limits. Help us recognize that your forgiveness is not earned; it interrupts our apologies, and is a gift unconditionally given.

Silent Confession *Please take a moment to contemplate God's love.*

Assurance of Pardon

Liturgist: God called Moses to lead the Israelites, the Spirit chose the women at the well to lead people to Jesus, the Father welcomes home the prodigal son. God does not turn away from humans who make mistakes, in fact, God runs towards them with open arms. God runs towards you. God runs towards your neighbor. God runs towards your enemy. This is the Good (and sometimes hard) News of Jesus.

People: Thanks be to God!


