Welcome and Announcements

Gathering Song: Seek Ye First

*Call to Worship:

Liturgist: I looked, and there was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, robed in white, with palm branches in their hands. They cried in a loud voice, saying,

People: "Salvation belongs to our God who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

Liturgist: Today our voices join this ongoing heavenly hymn of praise. In Jesus' name, let us worship God.

A Call to Confession (Liturgist)

Christ calls us to share the heavenly banquet of his love with all the saints on earth and in heaven. Knowing our unworthiness and sin, let us ask from God both mercy and forgiveness.

Unison Prayer of Confession (prayed aloud by all)

Eternal God, in every age you have raised up men and women to live and die in faith. Forgive our indifference to your will. You have commanded us to speak, but we have been silent. You have called us to do what is just, but we have been fearful.

Silent Confession Please take a moment for silent confession

Asking for God's Forgiveness

Liturgist: Let us now ask God's forgiveness.

People: Have mercy on us, your faithless servants. Keep before us faithful people to follow so that, by the power of your Holy Spirit, we may grow in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, to the praise of your holy name. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon

Liturgist: You are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling place for God.

People: Amen! Thanks be to God!

Sung Response to Confession: Breathe on Me, Breath of God
Breathe on me, Breath of God; fill me with life anew
That I may love what thou dost love, and do what thou wouldst do.
